



## **Top Ten Trump Accomplishments for Pro-life Americans and People of Faith**

- No. 1** Transformed the judiciary by appointing two constitutionalist justices to the Supreme Court, Neil Gorsuch and Brett Kavanaugh, and over 200 federal judges to the lower courts. [National Review, August 19, 2020](#)
- No. 2** Became first president to attend March for Life in Washington, D.C [Washington Post, January 22, 2020](#)
- No. 3** Signed executive order stating that faith-based employers and organizations like the Little Sisters of the Poor cannot be forced to violate their religious beliefs in order to comply with laws like the Affordable Care Act. [NBC News, May 17, 2017](#)
- No. 4** Implemented new rules to prevent Title X Family Planning funds from going to abortion clinics, shifted funds to community health centers and allowed states to exclude abortion providers from Medicaid programs. - No. 5** Reinstated the Mexico City Policy to prevent tax-funding of organizations that promote abortion as a method of family planning overseas. [NBC News, January 24, 2017](#)
- No. 6** Called on Congress to pass a ban on late-term abortions, the Pain-Capable Unborn Child Protection Act, and protection for babies who survive abortions and vowed to veto any bill weakening pro-life policies, including repeal of long-standing Hyde Amendment. - No. 8** Intervened to help free pastor Andrew Brunson from Turkish prison and took action against nations such as China and Iran that persecute religious and ethnic minorities.
